

Here is a history book with a difference. Writing originally for her own children, the author has gone out of her way to describe how God's hand is in control of the events of history at all times. What is normally called "church history" is woven into the narrative and its links with political and social events pointed out. Suitable for a wide range of ages, and with worksheets for those who wish to use the book more formally, the narrative is also excellent for reading aloud. Illustrated with many black and white line drawings which are ideal for children to colour.
